
## THE HILLS HAVE IRON

former lost the Second World War in 1945. In fact, even after the Japanese lost the war, the mass industry saw a


heightened demand from the Japanese as part of its post-war recovery efforts.



But the mining town is not without mystery. In the 1940s, rumours of gold whispered from both far and wide. It was said that the Japanese had stumbled upon gold amidst iron. Ask any Bukit Besi villager about the rumours of gold now and they would chuckle, having heard the question for decades. Many dismiss it as a myth. Some however, would claim that the gold was real, with chests






